




Then find the tournament **ITF AMERICA E-TOURNAMENT**


You can do this by scrolling the map to locate USA, then click on the little balloon or look for it in events, browser events and then click on ITF, look for the tournament logo and click.



Next, click on login at the top right of the screen.




Enter the account of your school / club, type username, password and then click on login.





Scroll down to individual entries for the chosen tournament and click the upload video icon.



Look for the competitor and the category to upload the videos, then click on the icon to upload the videos





Look for the video on your computer browser and load it by selecting it and then open or write the url where the video resides.



First, accept the terms and conditions and then upload the video by clicking upload.

Important! wait for the upload of the video to be completed. You can see the percentage where you clicked to upload the video.



To finish, accept the terms and conditions and then select the round (select your performance).

It is very important to select the round correctly and I send the video with a click on submit.

Now you can see the number of videos uploaded for that competitor in his category. The yellow color means pending approval.



Repeat the process, if it is necessary to continue uploading videos by clicking on the upload videos icon.

When the videos are in green it is suitable for qualification by the umpires and if it appears red it is rejected, it can also be reset by the Tournament administrator. The upload icon will be in white again as at the beginning and you can upload another video in the time that you It remains until the close of the round.

You will receive an email directly from sportdata notifying the rejection or reset of the video.
